REPORT OF ACADEMIC AUDIT 2023-24

The Academic Audit of various teaching departments of C.L.C. Government Arts and Commerce College, Dhamdha, was conducted on 30 May 2024, by the designated Audit Team as per the guidelines set during the meeting of the Academic Council of the college.

To ensure the effectiveness of the academic audit, a common audit team was constituted for the faculties of Science, Commerce, and Arts.

Key Highlights of the Audit

- 13. Extension activities, consultancy efforts, and collaborations were reviewed for impact and relevance.
- 14. The library's role as a learning resource and its accessibility to students and faculty were assessed.
- 15. Maintenance of departmental infrastructure and facilities was checked for adequacy.
- 16. Environmental consciousness, innovative practices, and leadership roles were analyzed to identify strengths and areas for improvement.
